

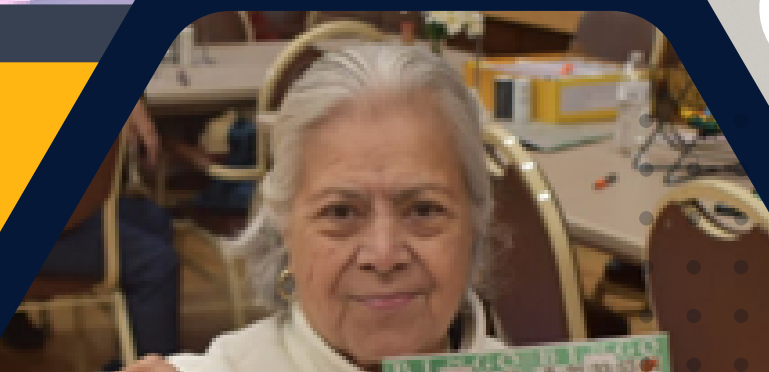

Flags of Valor

Flags of Valor is a week-long event honoring Active Duty, Veteran, and Fallen Military Personnel, with sponsored flags available for \$25 to support local veterans through essential services. An Opening Ceremony will be held on Monday, May 18, 2026, at 5:30

p.m. at the Dean L. Shively Middle School Front Lawn, followed by a flag retirement ceremony on Wednesday, May 20, 2026, at 5:30 p.m., where community members may bring worn American flags for proper retirement.

Memorial Day Ceremony

The City of South El Monte will host their annual Memorial Day Ceremony scheduled for Monday, May 25, 2026, which is a day of remembrance and mourning our nation’s heroes. The ceremony commemorates our heroes with a 21-gun salute, poem reading, TAPS, and a complimentary meal for all in attendance.

Deputy Day

The Deputy Day event, scheduled on Wednesday, May 27, 2026, is an informative event that provides students with the opportunity to engage with the local public servant agencies and learn more about their roles in our community. The event features a meet-and-greet with deputies, a K9 unit demonstration, patrol car and equipment display, safety tips and fun activities.

Community Bike Rides (June)

Open to riders of all skill levels, the event offers a safe and scenic 8-mile-long route through the city, encouraging residents to explore local neighborhoods, parks, and bike-friendly infrastructure. The Community Bike Rides take place on the first Saturday of every month, from March to October. The next Community Bike Ride is scheduled on Saturday, June 6, 2026.

Summer Night Markets

The Summer Night Market Series, scheduled two times a month on Thursdays, is a vibrant community event that brings together local vendors, artisans, and food trucks for an evening of shopping, entertainment, and cultural experiences. Featuring live music, delicious cuisine, handcrafted goods, and interactive activities, the market creates a lively atmosphere for residents to explore and support small businesses.

International Soccer Watch Parties

The City of South El Monte will host International Soccer Watch Parties at the Kruse Property in celebration of the 2026 FIFA World Cup. The watch parties will run from June 11, 2026, through July 19, 2026, featuring select high-demand matches, a children’s fun zone, a beer garden, and sufficient seating and tables for spectators to enjoy the games in a community setting.

Movies in the Park

The Movies in the Park Series, scheduled once a month on Thursday, kicks off on Thursday, June 18, 2026, at Mary Van Dyke Park. The event features pre-movie family activities, complimentary food, and a family-friendly movie.

Spring Aquatics Programming

Adult Basketball League
